

SAMPLE RESPONSE

If you forget too much, it can be a problem for you later in the future. The most helpful thing, whether it'll be in a journal, on your tablet, or on your phone, is creating a to-do list. You can also follow the advice many instructors give about best practices in note taking. Don't bother taking down things word-for-word. Just jot down quick facts or ideas as you go.

I have read an evidence that this isn't a complete myth. A survey of 2,000 British people conducted in 2013 found that men become bored after only 26 minutes of shopping, while it took women a full two hours.



The survey found that 80 percent of men didn't like shopping with their partners, and that 45 percent avoiding doing so at all costs. Almost half of all spousal shopping trips ended in arguments, with men becoming frustrated because they bought what they needed straight away, while their partners were still looking and taking too long to make decisions.

Buying a house




